

To whom it may concern:

Once again we look ahead to spring and summer, and what comes to mind for those of us involved in Kart racing... High Speed Family Fun and Excitement!!!!

We the members of the New Brunswick Karting Club realize that our racing series at our track on The Speedway 660 oval would not be possible without the help of our sponsors. For those of you that are not familiar with our club I will give you a brief rundown. We were formed in 2000, we were then known as the New Brunswick International Kart Club, and we have since dropped the International, and go by NBKC. We are a non-profit club, and such rely heavily on parent involvement and on corporate sponsors. Races from ages 6 to 66 years of age have the following classes:

Pre-Novice- (ages 6-8) Karts (min. 220lbs) with restricted 5.5HP Honda engine.

Novice- (Ages 8-12) Karts (min. 250lbs) with slightly modified restricted 5.5HP Honda engines.

Junior Light- (Ages 13-15) Karts (min. 290lbs) Modified restricted 5.5HP Honda engines, Speeds of 60 MPH

Junior Heavy- (Ages 13-15) Karts (min. 320lbs) Modified unrestricted 5.5HP Honda engines, Speeds of 60 MPH

Senior Light- (Ages 15-100) Karts (min. 340lbs) Modified unrestricted 6.5HP Honda engines, Speeds of 60 MPG

Senior Heavy- (Ages 15-100) Karts (min. 370lbs) Modified unrestricted 6.5HP Honda engines, Speeds of 60 MPH

Senior Yamaha- 100CC KT-100 2 Cycle Engine (Ages 15-100) Karts (min. 350lbs) Modified KT-100 Yamaha Engine Air Cooled, Speeds of 70 MPH

We make a schedule that includes only Saturday racing. We race on parts of the oval tract and parts of our own track. With the support of sponsors and fundraising we have been able to pave parts of the infield for our own use. We race using the international Karting Rules of ASN Canada and also follow their professional safety rules. (Every driver wears SNELL rated helmet, neck brace, suits, gloves and footwear). Safety is our first priority and we have Paramedics present at each race. The emphasis is on competitive family fun and we have a strict behaviour code at the track to insure all participants enjoy their day at the track.

The New Brunswick Karting Club has the following opportunities to participate in our sponsorship programs.

RACE SPONSOR:

We are looking for a class sponsorship for each class run at the track (as listed above).
